

**CLIVE PUGH Funeral Directors - STANDARDISED PRICE LIST - 2025**

All funeral directors are legally required to publish this price list for a standardised set of products and services. This is to help you think through your options and make choices, and to let you compare prices between different funeral directors, because prices can vary.

**ATTENDED FUNERAL (funeral director’s charges only) £1,645.00**

This is a funeral where family and friends have a ceremony, event or service for the deceased at the same time as they attend their burial or cremation.

- 1. Taking care of all necessary legal and administrative arrangements **£100.00**
  - 2. Collecting and transporting the deceased **out of hours** from the place of death (normally within 15 miles of the funeral director’s premises) into the funeral director’s care **£325.00**
  - 3. Care of the deceased before the funeral in appropriate facilities **£485.00**
  - 4. Providing a suitable coffin – this will be made from veneered oak (light colour) **£365.00**
  - 5. Viewing of the deceased person for family and friends, by appointment **Included**
  - 6. At a date and time you agree with the funeral director, taking the deceased direct to the agreed cemetery or crematorium in a hearse or appropriate vehicle. **£450.00**
- A limousine for the family (normally within 20 miles of the funeral directors premises) to take the family to the cemetery or crematorium.

**UNATTENDED FUNERAL**

This is a funeral where family and friends may choose to have a ceremony, event or service for the deceased person, but they do not attend the burial or cremation itself.

- 1. Burial (funeral director’s charges only) **£1,645.00**
- 2. Cremation (funeral director’s charges plus the cremation fee) **£2,644.00**

**FEES YOU MUST PAY**

For an Attended or Unattended burial funeral, the **burial fee**.<sup>1</sup> **£ P O A**  
 In this local area, the typical cost of the burial fee for local residents is: **£ P O A**

For a new grave, you will also need to pay for the plot; for an existing grave with a memorial in place, you may need to pay a removal/replacement fee. In addition, the cemetery may charge a number of other fees.

For an Attended cremation funeral, the **cremation fee**. **£658.00**  
 In this local area, the typical cost of a cremation for local residents is: **£1,099.00**

<sup>1</sup> This fee (which is sometimes called the interment fee) is the charge made for digging and closing a new grave, or for reopening and closing an existing grave.

**ADDITIONAL FUNERAL DIRECTOR PRODUCTS AND SERVICES**

This funeral director may be able to supply a range of optional, additional products and services, or to arrange on your behalf, for a third party to supply them. The funeral director can give you a full list of what they can supply. They are likely to charge for additional products and services, so you may choose to take care of some arrangements without their involvement, or you can use a different supplier.

- 1. Additional mileage (price per mile) **£1.45 per mile**
- 2. Additional transfers of the deceased’s body (e.g. to their home, to a place of worship etc.) **Included**
- 3. Collection and delivery of ashes **Price on request**
- 4. Embalming **Included**
- 5. Funeral Officiant (minister of religion, celebrant, humanist minister) **£220.00 - £250.00**
- 6. Services supplied outside of normal office hours **Included**
